- 1) Agree to not host or participate in a block sale, street sale, garage sale, estate sale or yard sale during the Northwest Buffalo Tour of Gardens (NWBTOG).
- 2) You commit to have your garden available to patrons during the established day and hours set by the NWBTOG, if you chose to participate in the traditional tour options.
- 3) Please keep all animals confined to a safe area or chained up if outside. This is for the benefit of both the animals and patrons.
- 4) If participating in the Starry Night Garden Tours, you agree to have decorative lighting throughout your garden, as this is the purpose of the event.
- 5) The NWTOG sign will be displayed on your front yard during the day and hours of the NWTOG.
- 6) Please use safety practices during the NWTOG. There are headquarters throughout the tour where refreshments and restrooms are available. You are NOT under any obligations to open your home to anyone. Again, please use safety practices.
