



Seed Bank Instructions

Zinnias

- Full sun exposure
- Plant seeds $\frac{1}{4}$ inch deep and at least 4 inches apart
- Before sprouting, water daily
- Once growth starts, water plant lightly
- Thin leaves when plant reaches 3 inches to help with growth

Purple Coneflower

- Full sun exposure
- Thrives in most soil types except overly moist soil
- Plant $\frac{1}{2}$ -1 inch deep
- Drought-resistant flower; does not require much watering
- Can grow 2-4 feet tall
- Perennials; Will grow year after year

Gloriosa Daisy

- Full sun exposure
- Thrives in nutrient-rich soil
- Can grow 2-3 feet tall
- Plant seeds at least 8-10 inches apart
- Allow seeds to dry in between watering; does not require much watering
- Low maintenance

Marigolds

- Full sun exposure
- Thrives in any soil type
- Moisten and loosen soil 6 inches deep before planting
- Plant seeds 1 inch deep
- When flowers are established, prune tops and remove dried buds to enhance growth
- Allow soil to dry in between watering
